

NOTICE OF CANCELLATION

As required by Kansas & Federal Law

You may cancel this Agreement at any time, for any reason within three (3) business days from the date of this Agreement.

If the Agreement is cancelled within this time, any deposits will be returned to you, without penalty, following receipt by the Company of the Cancellation Notice, within 10 days.

If you cancel, you must make available to the Contractor at your residence, in substantially as good condition as when received, any goods delivered to you under this contractor sale; or you may, if you wish, comply with the instructions of the Contractor regarding the return shipment of the goods at the Contractor's expense and risk.

To cancel this Agreement, mail or deliver a signed and dated copy of this Cancellation Notice or other written notice to Heartland Roof & Gutter, LLC, 1037 S. McComas, Wichita, KS 67213 by no later than midnight of the third business day from the date of this Agreement.

Saturdays, Sundays and holidays do not count as business days.

Overview of the Three Day Right of Recession Law

A contractor who presents you a agreement proposal away from their principle place of business is required to inform you of your state and federal recession rights as a consumer and provide you a with a cancellation form such as the one.

If you approve any agreement away from a company's principle place of business (i.e. your home) or if your initial contact with the company was initiated by the contractor then you the law allows you three (3) business days to think the agreement over. You may at anytime prior to midnight of the 3rd full business day cancel such an agreement and you are entitled to a full refund when this right is exercised. A business day is any day other than Saturday, Sunday or an officially recognized holiday by the state of Kansas or the federal government. Keep a copy of the cancellation form if you submit it. If you cancel the Contractor has ten days to refund your deposit and return the agreement note. The Contractor is allowed to pickup any materials given to you as part of the sale including sales materials, project itemization, plans, etc.

These notes are for you convenience. We recommend that you consult your attorney if you have any questions related to your actual rights concerning cancellation.
